



The 2017 finalists in the Health Care & Wellness category share a mission that is about improving our area's wellbeing. Health care businesses are predicted to have the fastest growth of all industries between 2014 and 2024, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.



# GULFCOAST SOUTH AREA HEALTH EDUCATION CENTER

The Gulfcoast South Area Health Education Center (GSAHEC) has provided health education to improve the well being of the communities it serves for more than 20 years. That includes developing,



implementing, and evaluating health education and awareness programs and facilitating access to quality health care in Sarasota, Charlotte, Desoto, and Manatee Counties.

GSAHEC runs health career camps and mentoring programs for youth, medical interpreting training for local healthcare providers, and works to improve the access and quality of health care for medically underserved individuals. Since 2007, GSAHEC has also provided tobacco cessation services. The organization's mandate is to use the resources of academic medicine to address local community health needs, help correct healthcare inequities, and strengthen the community's health care safety net.

# HEARING LOSS ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA - SARASOTA MANATEE

The mission of the Hearing Loss Association (HLAA) of Sarasota Manatee is to expand communication for the 145,000 local people with hearing loss by providing information, education, advocacy, and support. The nonprofit, launched locally in 1988, teaches members how to self-help and self-advocate for their hearing needs.

The HLAA's impact has been significant. Its promotional



and financial support efforts, including securing underwriting grants, has resulted in the installation of more hearing loop systems in Sarasota than any other city in the U.S. More than 120 local venues – theatres, meeting places, houses of worship, and more – have acquired these 'access technology' systems thanks to HLAA. Loop systems work by sending a voice from a microphone on stage, directly into the hearing aid of audience members, significantly improving their clarity and understanding of communication.

### DR. THOMAS A. BOWLES, D.D.S., P.A.

Innovation, education and state-of-the-art dentistry, in a relaxing and inviting atmosphere, are the hallmarks of the offices of Dr. Thomas A. Bowles, D.D.S., P.A. The



### SAFE PLACE AND RAPE CRISIS CENTER (SPARCC)

The Safe Place and Rape Crisis Center's (SPARCC) mission is "to lead, inform and inspire the people of our communities to create and maintain an environment free of domestic and sexual abuse and violence." Starting as a non-profit battered women's shelter in 1979 with one staff member and a few volunteers. SPARCC



is now an agency with a 24-bed shelter, an outreach center,

five transitional housing apartments, satellite outreach offices, onsite advocacy services in area courthouses, and an educational/prevention program.

As the only state-certified center for domestic violence and sexual assault services for Sarasota and DeSoto counties, all of SPARCC's services are free and confidential.

The agency provides a 24-hour hotline service for victims, safety planning, emergency shelter, counseling, information, referrals, and more.

### SUNCOAST **BLOOD BANK**

The singular purpose of the non-profit SunCoast Blood Bank is to collect, test, process, match. store and distribute all the blood products required to serve our

community. When it began, in 1949, 551 pints (or units) of blood were collected. Now more than 38,000 units of blood are collected. The organization exclusively serves 10 crucial area hospitals and health centers annually, including the Sarasota Memorial Healthcare System (SMH) and Doctors Hospital of Sarasota.





SunCoast Blood Bank is recognized by its peers as forward thinking and cutting edge. It maintains a proactive stance that, for example, reacted quickly to the threat of Zika; so much so, that they were ready to test for the virus in advance of the federal mandate and many other blood banks in Florida. SunCoast Blood Bank also distinguishes itself through outstanding customer service, demonstrated through personalized and sincere interactions with every donor and quest.
