

The name Tamiami Trail comes from the fact that this road was the main route connecting Tampa to Miami. Whether you're a local or a visitor, this scenic drive offers a year-round invitation to discover the charm, warmth, and countless treasures along the way.



L Selby Gardens Historic Spanish Point

The past is present at **Selby Gardens Historic Spanish Point**. Discover a vibrant tapestry of archaeological splendor, botanical beauty, and 5,000 years of Floridian history for your exploration. *selby.org*

2 Bay Preserve at Osprey

Turn west on Blackburn Point Road to go over the one-lane **Blackburn Point Historic Swing Bridge**. Built in 1926, it's still manually operated by a bridge tender.

7 Casey Key or Tamiami Trail

You can go this-a-way: Keep driving on Blackburn Point Road for a four-mile scenic drive through **Casey Key**. Or, better yet, you can turn back and head south towards **Nokomis** to continue your **Tamiami Trail** adventure.


8 Total Impact Guns + Range
